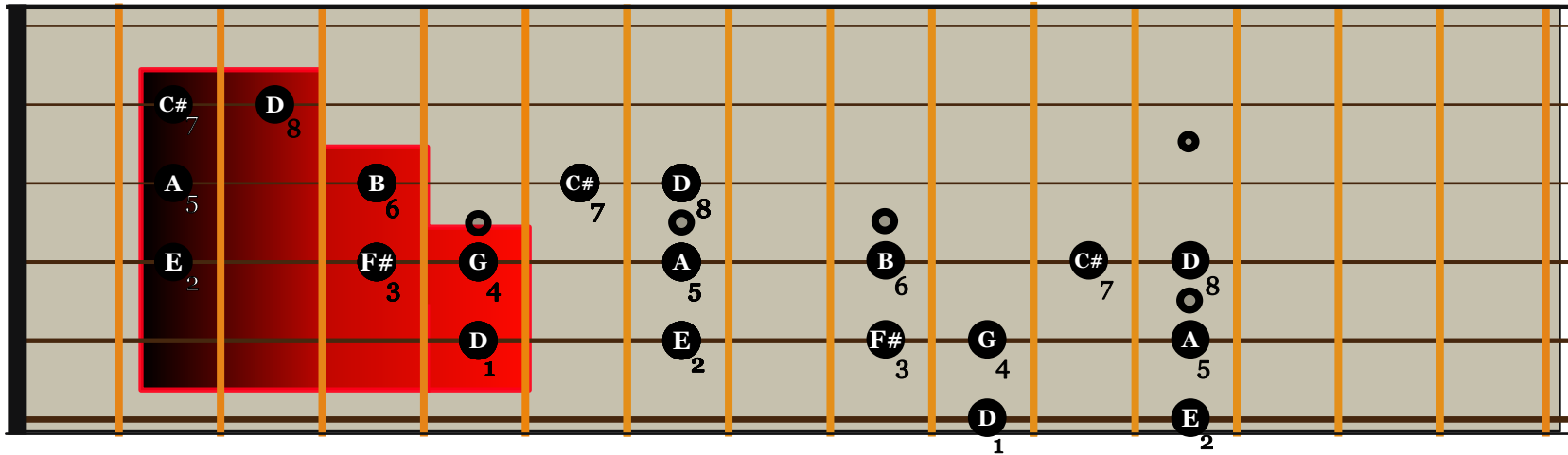


D Major Scale

If we take the pattern 1 thru 8 from the previous lesson and place the root note on the 6th string / 10 fret (D note) you will see that these patterns repeat.

And, you will be glad to know, they are common in every Major scale from A to G. Additionally!! The scales are now linked together...

As mentioned before, playing scales backwards and forwards is something that you want to learn.

If you play the notes 1 thru 8 anywhere along this example, there are enough variants to keep you practicing for hours.
