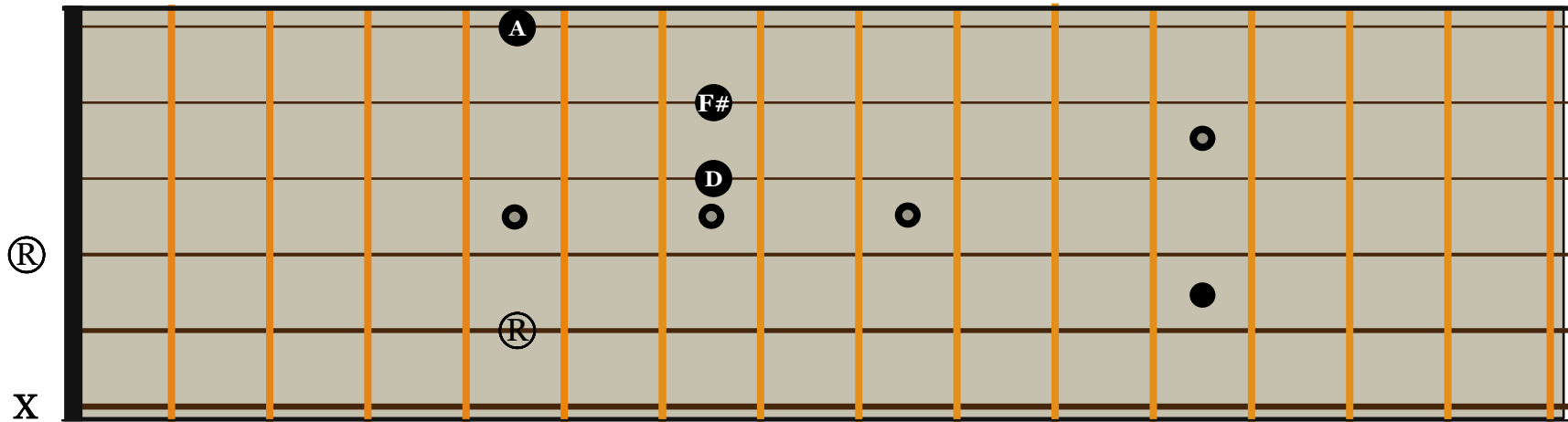


D Major Chord

Guitar 101



Here is a simpler approach to the D Major.

You know from Lesson 3 that the root note D is located at the 5th String, 5th fret.

But, take an even closer look at the three notes on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd strings.

Omitting one or both of the **R** root notes still leaves you with a "Triad" (1, 3, 5)

The chord diagram shown above is a D Major chord. **Note that 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 are represented**

○ represents an open string

D F# A D

● represents a fretted position

R represents a "Root Note"

X indicates the string is omitted
